Children's clothing

Please ensure <u>all</u> items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name (including spare changes, coats, outdoor shoes etc.). Indoor shoes should be placed in your child's blue/red drawstring bag at the end of each session as the shoe boxes are shared.

Any clothing items found without a name will be put in our lost property box in the cloakroom. We will empty these at the end of each term.

Outdoor Play

Children will have access to outdoor play in all weathers. Please ensure your child comes to nursery in weather appropriate clothing, for example, wearing a waterproof jacket and wellies on wet days.

Snack

The cost of snack remains at £1.50 a week this year. Please pay any snack money on a Monday to the member of staff at the painting table.

Stay, Play and Learn

We enjoy working in partnership with our parents/carers and therefore would like to invite you to attend Stay, Play and Learn. These sessions enable parents/carers to share in their child's play and learning opportunities in the nursery setting. Dates and details of our upcoming Stay, Play and Learn sessions will soon be displayed in our cloakroom.

This year we are going to offer one session each month throughout the year and would ask that parents/carers sign up for one visit only as we will have a limited number of spaces. Please contact the nursery if you are unable to visit the cloakroom to sign up and we can add your name.
