## Our learning this term

We have had a busy couple of months since the initial interest in the nursery all about trains.

Children were very keen to explore and investigate different bridges, especially the new Queensferry

Crossing as many of our children had been to visit it.

Children have had opportunities to investigate how bridges stay up using the computer to research and through practical experiments to construct their own bridges using a range of resources.

We have explored the story of The Three Billy Goats Gruff which prompted children to construct their own bridges and role play using goat puppets to retell the story.

We have also been fortunate to have a visit from two parents who work in the railway industry to talk to the children. One parent, who is a train driver, brought posters to discuss with the children, and the red and green flags used to signal the trains were of great interest to the children. Children have been discussing the use of red and green for traffic, particularly at road crossings, which has resulted in the current focus on road safety.

We really enjoy involving our parents and carers in our learning. If your child has discussed any of these areas of interest with you at home, please add them to our planning wall in the cloakroom or ask to see our Floorbook and you can note them in there.
