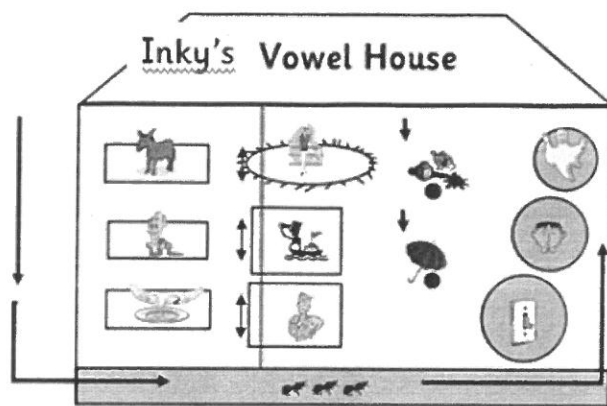

What did he say?



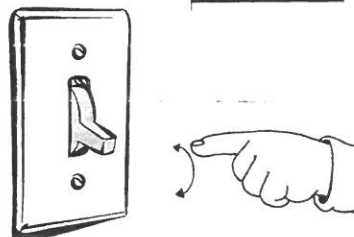
Down on the ground floor, mum is in the kitchen cracking eggs 'e'.

It's very dark. Quick! Let's turn on the light 'o'.

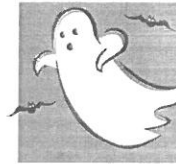


Oh no! It is broken and it's not working! 'oa'

Listen! Who can you hear in the darkness?a spook going 'oo'

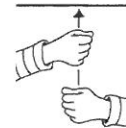


This scares poor Inky mouse.

Rub tummy, seeing tasty food and say *mmm*

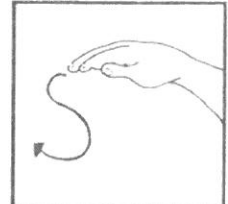

Raise hands and snap fingers together as if playing castanets, and say *k k k*

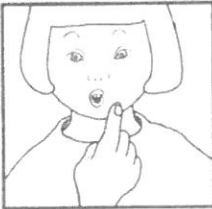

Pretend to be a mouse, by wiggling fingers on end of your nose (whiskers), and squeak *i i i*

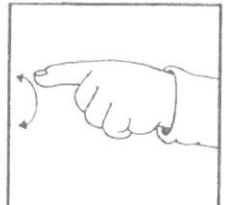

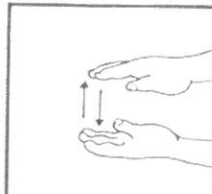

Place hands together as if bailing a ball, and say b b b.

H h

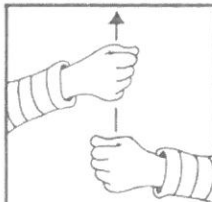


ACTION

U u

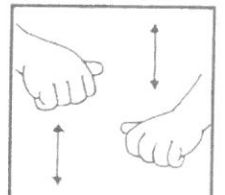

Keep one hand steady and raise the other, as if raising an umbrella, and say u u u up.

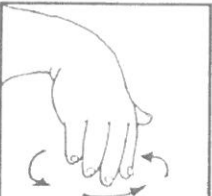

Pretend to be a bee, with elbows in, and hands flapping, saying zzzzzzzzzzz.

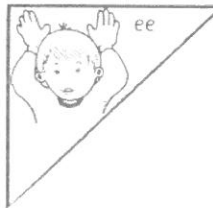

Pretend to take an x-ray with an x-ray camera, saying ks, ks, ks.

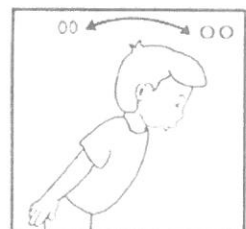

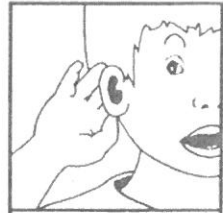


ACTION

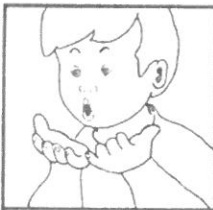

ch

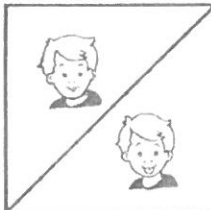


Action

Pretend to be a jelly, and wobble, saying j j j jelly.

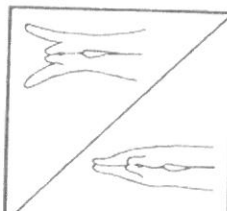

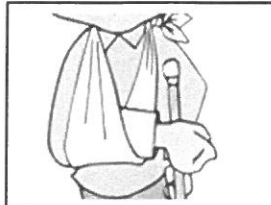

and back to the stalk



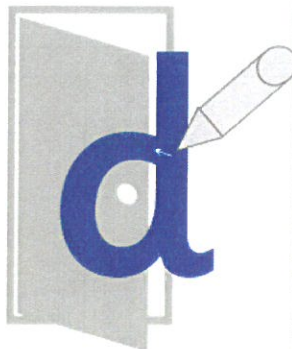
start at the stalk

the hard roof of the mouth.



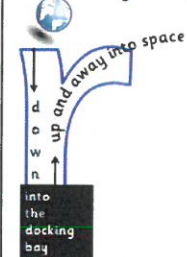
